**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-02-01
IN SUPPORT OF SECOND AMENDMENT RIGHTS**

WHEREAS, The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America affirms that it is the natural, God-given Right of the people to keep and bear arms, and protects Americans against any infringement of this Right; and

WHEREAS, our state's governor and legislature have demonstrated their intent to pass legislation that would infringe upon the rights of the people; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Johnstown Township Board took an oath to support the Second (2nd) Amendment of the Constitution of the United States of America and Article 1 Section 6 of the State of Michigan Constitution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Johnstown Township Board declares their support for the Second Amendment rights of all Barry County citizens as protected by the United State Constitution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Johnstown Township Board declares Johnstown Township, locate in Barry County, Michigan, a township that strongly preserves and protects the right of the people to keep and bear arms; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Johnstown Township Board will do everything in their power to defend the God-given, unalienable rights of the citizens of Johnstown Township from any and all infringements.
